AN ORDINANCE REVISING THE CORPORATE SEAL OF THE CITY OF BACOOR.

Sponsored by: Hon. Reynaldo M. Fabian, Hon. Venus D. De Castro, Hon. Reynaldo D. Palabrica, Hon. Bayani M. De Leon, and Hon. Catherine Sarino- Evaristo.

WHEREAS, the City of Bacoor was created by virtue of the approval and subsequent ratification of Republic Act No. 10160:

WHEREAS, one of the corporate powers of the city government as embodied in Section 3 of Republic Act No. 10160 is to have and use a corporate seal;

WHEREAS, the present seal being used by the city government was adopted before the approval of the above-mentioned law at a time when Bacoor was still a municipality;

WHEREAS, the Office of the City Mayor submitted a letter requesting the Sangguniang Panlungsod to revise the seal currently being used by the city government in view of the creation of the City of Bacoor by legislative fiat;

WHEREAS, the said matter was referred to the Committee on Legal Matters and Ordinances headed by Councilor Venus De Castro;

WHEREAS, the Committee on Ordinances and Legal Matters conducted numerous committee hearings attended by various stakeholders and members of reputable non-government organizations and recommended the approval of one of the proposed designs for the corporate seal of the city submitted by the Office of the City Mayor.


WHEREAS, Section 44 of Republic Act No. 8491 authorized all government entities to adopt the appropriate administrative seals and other heraldic devices.

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby ordained by the Sangguniang Panlungsod in special session assembled that:

Short Title. -- This ordinance shall also be known as Section 1. the "Corporate Seal Ordinance of the City of Bacoor".

Design of the Corporate Seal .--Corporate Section 2. The Seal shall contain the following design features with the corresponding symbols for each:

Design Features	Symbolic Meaning
a) The numbers "1671" appearing on the façade of a representation of a bridge	Symbolizes the year (1671) when the town of Bacoor was founded
b) Double concentric rings	Represents the continuity of Bacoor's time- honored traditions despite its conversion into a city
c) Representation of a bridge made of bricks appearing on the foreground	Symbolizes the Zapote Bridge where the historic Battle of Zapote Bridge took place during the Philippine Revolution
d) Seventy three rectangular shapes appearing on the façade of the bridge representation	Symbolizes the seventy three barangays of the City of Bacoor and how the cooperation of each contributes to the stability of the city
e) Representation of a bamboo appearing on the left hand corner	Denotes the irrepressible bamboo from which the name of the city was taken and signifies the resilient nature of the character of its people
f) Representation of mussel shells appearing equidistant from each other within the dual concentric rings	Signifies the main agricultural produce of the city and its two new district
g) Yellow sun rayonnant with eight outward pointing rays	Symbolizes the eight provinces the first took up arms against the Spaniards during the Philippine Revolution which includes the province of Cavite
h) Representation of buildings appearing on background	Denotes the progressive nature of the city
i) White background	Represents the peaceful nature of the people of

Bacoor
Signifies the courage of Bacooreños and their determination to fight for freedom
Symbolizes the city government's commitment to save the environment and its pristine water resources as well as the calmness and serenity which are hallmarks of the people of Bacoor's character
Stands for the year when RA 10160 was approved by Congress and ratified resoundingly by the people of Bacoor in a plebiscite
Symbolizes the eleven existing musical marching bands in Bacoor that were established in 1925 that has become a familiar fixture in all important events that took place in Bacoor over the years

Section 3. Use of the Corporate Seal of the City of Bacoor. - The corporate seal of the City of Bacoor shall be affixed to or placed upon all official communications of the city government. It shall also be prominently displayed on the walls of all edifices owned and operated by the city government.

Section 4. *Effectivity.* -- This ordinance shall become effective immediately after it has been posted in at least three conspicuous places within the City of Bacoor and after it has been approved by the National Commission for Culture and the Arts.

Section 6. Separability clause. – If any provision, or part hereof, is held invalid or unconstitutional, the remainder of this ordinance not otherwise affected shall be valid and subsisting.

Section 7. Repealing clause. – Any ordinance, resolution, executive order, letter of instruction, administrative order, rule or regulation contrary to, or inconsistent with, the provisions of this ordinance is hereby repealed, modified, or amended accordingly.

Section 8. *Dissemination.*- Let copies of this Ordinance be furnished to the Office of the City Mayor, the National Commission for Culture and the Arts, and other government offices concerned.
