About the 123rd Philippine Civil Service Anniversary

The Civil Service Commission (CSC) will lead the 123rd Philippine Civil Service Anniversary (PCSA) in September, in accordance with Presidential Proclamation No. 1050, series of 1997, declaring such month as the Civil Service Month. This also commemorates the establishment of the Philippine Civil Service by virtue of Public Law No. 5 (An Act for the Establishment and Maintenance of an Efficient and Honest Civil Service in the Philippine Islands) on 19 September 1900.

The said proclamation also highlights the involvement of all agencies in the celebration. It states: "All agencies, offices and instrumentalities of government shall implement the programs promulgated by the Civil Service Commission and shall actively participate, as well as ensure the active involvement of their officials and employees, in the activities that the Commission may deem necessary for the meaningful and successful celebration of the Civil Service Month."

The CSC has adopted a 10-year theme, "Transforming Public Service in the Next Decade: Honing Agile and Future-Ready Servant-Heroes," emphasizing the government workforce's adaptability to the new normal. This theme underscores the importance of digital transformation, innovation, and upholding excellence and continuity in public service. This year's focus of celebration is on DYNAMISM, highlighting its role in enhancing organizational resilience and sustainable management while aligning with the aspirations of *AmBisyon Natin* 2040.

About this Branding Guide

This digital booklet aims to guide government agencies on the specifications of collaterals that they will produce as part of their participation in the 123rd PCSA celebration and any of the lined-up activities. It also contains rules on the correct usage of logos, colors, and visual elements.

With this branding guide, the CSC hopes to establish a consistent look for all 123rd PCSA-related collaterals across the bureaucracy and establish recall of the PCSA celebration among the general public. This is also a show of solidarity in the civil service, stressing how the bureaucracy can work in unison toward common goals.

Use of the 123rd PCSA Logo, Color Palette, and Other Elements



This is the CSC-approved logo to be used for the 123rd PCSA celebration.

Observe the following rules in the use of the 123rd PCSA logo:

- The logo should not be modified, altered, or tampered.
- Provide a three-centimeter clear space around the logo

Use of the CSC Logo




The CSC logo may only be used by CSC offices. Government agencies and other organizations with existing partnerships with the CSC related to any 123rd PCSA activity may use the CSC logo on their collaterals, provided that prior coordination must be made with the partner CSC office before dissemination.

All CSC offices must ensure compliance with the Logo Usage Guidelines specified in the CSC Stylebook.

123rd PCSA Collaterals

Streamer Specifications: 6 x 4 feet





Banner Specifications: 8 x 6 feet

All government agencies/offices are encouraged to print the 123rd PCSA streamer or banner on tarpaulin material, and display it on the façade of the office with high visibility and/or foot traffic.

Affix the agency logo on the space provided. The dimensions of the streamer/banner may be modified to suit the display requirements of the agency/office.

Posting period: 28 August - 30 September 2023

Facebook Profile Frame Specifications: 183 x 183 px



All government officials and employees are encouraged to apply the profile frame on their individual Facebook profile photos.

The poster may be displayed on bulletin boards or entrances/doors. Affix the agency logo on the space provided. The dimensions of the poster may be modified to suit the display requirements of the agency/office.

Posting period: 28 August - 30 September 2023

Button pin Specifications: 2.5 x 2.5 inches

The CSC will be distributing button pins for government employees, but due to the limited quantity, government agencies may also opt to produce button pins for their respective employees. Affix the agency logo on the space provided.



Website Banner Specifications: 1160 x 390 px



All government agencies/offices are encouraged to display the website banner on their respective websites. Upon clicking the banner, it may lead to a webpage containing the following text:
